# Nutritional Screening using 'MUST'

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BAPEN, a Charitable Association that raises awareness of malnutrition and works to advance the nutritional care of patients and those at risk from malnutrition in the wider community has partnered with NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde to develop a series of three interactive e-Learning modules on nutritional screening using 'MUST' ('Malnutrition Universal Screening Tool').

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Designed for health and care staff working in hospitals, primary care and care homes, the three modules explain the causes and consequences of malnutrition, the importance of nutritional screening and how to screen using 'MUST'. Each module includes case studies and care plans appropriate for the work place and an online assessment together with the ability to print off certificates of achievement.

## Key Features include:

- Tailored case studies to meet staff needs and place of work
- Interactive and online
- Approximately 45 minutes on average to complete
- End of course assessment and certificate of completion

Undertaking these modules will equip staff to play a key part in improving the nutritional care of their residents/patients/clients as well as ensure compliance with the Care Quality Commission regulations, national nutritional care standards and the NICE Quality Standard for Nutritional Support in Adults.

All three e-Learning modules are SCORM compliant and can be published to link into the learning management systems (LMS) used by trusts or organisations to record completion of e-Learning courses. However, for trusts or organisations that need to launch and track the completion of the 'MUST' e-Learning modules but do not use an LMS, BAPEN now offers a managed learning environment (MLE) where the modules can be accessed via the BAPEN website ([www.bapen.org.uk](http://www.bapen.org.uk)). The modules can be customised to include trust or organisational logo, a welcome from a senior manager and links to local care plans if desired. Costs for customisation will depend on the work required.

## What is a Managed Learning Environment?

The MLE is a secure web based system that can be tailored to meet the needs of your organisation. The system is completely managed by the team at BAPEN. All you need to do is provide a list of your learners and BAPEN will do the rest.

On a monthly basis the names of your learners will be uploaded and the list updated as people leave and new staff are employed. This MLE removes the need to acquire an LMS and reduces administration. There are three packages available depending on the level of customisation and branding required.



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## Gold Package

- This option provides a bespoke home page for your organisation held within the MLE. Learners will access the module via your own home page which can include your organisational logo, any relevant documents, contacts etc. By having your own home page, your learners will clearly appreciate the support for nutrition education and training provided by your organisation.
- The 'MUST' e-Learning module you require will be customised to include a personalised welcome page, organisational logo on the opening page and the certificate of completion and the inclusion of a link to your nutritional policy / pathway.
- Each month you will get management reports showing you who has successfully completed the module.

## Silver Package

- This option enables your staff to access the module directly.
- The 'MUST' e-Learning module you require will be customised to include a personalised welcome page, organisational logo on the opening page and the certificate of completion and the inclusion of a link to your nutritional policy / pathway.
- Each month you will get management reports showing you who has successfully completed the module.

## Bronze Package

- This option enables your staff to access a standard version of the 'MUST' module of your choice.
- Each month you will get management reports showing you who have successfully completed the module.
