nutritionDay certificates for non-ICU hospital wards and nursing homes

Certificates will be provided for all non-ICU hospital units and nursing homes which reach the defined participation limits. Make sure you reach the required limits for your units!

1. Minimum of 8 patients/residents have to be included in the audit per unit (this is also the minimum number required to receive a unit report)
2. Minimum of 60% of all patients/residents present on nD have to be included in the nD audit.
3. Minimum of 80% of patients/residents (which have participated on nutritionDay) have to be included in the outcome evaluation 30/180 days after nD.



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
