



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

BAPEN

And

Bright Nutrition Ltd

Date Raised: Nov 2024

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is intended to represent a clear undertaking by BAPEN and Bright Nutrition Ltd to enable the delivery of successful pre-registration dietetic placements for students. This to remain in place until January 2028.

Background:

BAPEN has a history of working with Bright Nutrition Ltd to provide pre-registration dietetic placements for students. These are required for qualification and HCPC registration as a dietitian. BAPEN has traditionally informed on appropriate and useful topics for student projects which contribute to the work of BAPEN and enable student learning outcomes to be met.

Specific aims & outcomes:

The aim of the placement programme is to support students in their education and development towards gaining their qualifications as registered dietitians. BAPEN will continue to offer advice to Bright Nutrition Ltd on appropriate project topics as required and will support the delivery of the project outcomes reports upon completion.

Roles and Responsibilities

Bright Nutrition Ltd will hold individual student placement contracts directly with each of the participating universities and will act as placement supervisor and will be responsible for:

- Liaison with the University about the students, placement plan and submission of paperwork.
- Development of the project and preparation of supporting information
- Provision of a timetable to include supervision, meetings and assessments.
- Provision of regular supervision, support and advice.
- Management of any issues regarding student learning, behaviour or performance.
- Provision of a final assessment.
- Dissemination of student project findings as appropriate and agree any follow-on work.
- Provision of a report for BAPEN Executive following each student placement.



BAPEN will act in an advisory capacity to Bright Nutrition Ltd and will provide support as required including but not limited to:

- Offering guidance and advice on useful topics for student projects which may contribute to the work of BAPEN and enable student learning outcomes to be met.
- Provide financial and logistical support for the printing of abstract posters for up to 10 students who have abstracts accepted to the BAPEN annual conference.
- Offer ad hoc advice and support as required by Bright Nutrition to ensure the successful completion of the student placements and to ensure that the aims and objectives are met.

Funding

All university contracts and payments will be held between Bright Nutrition Ltd and the individual institutions.

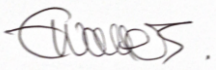
